## **Introduction :**

The Berar General Education Society started Berar Arts College in the year 1937. In 1938, it was renamed as Sitabai Arts College after its donor the Late Smt. Sitabai Jain. In the year 1958, commerce faculty was added to the college. Looking at the rapid growth of the commerce faculty, it was felt necessary to make it a separate independent unit.

Seth Shri. Radhakisan Toshniwal a great philanthropist of Akola donated a sum of Rs.25000 and a piece of Land measuring about 3 acres in the heart of the city in the fond memory of his wife Smt. Laxmibai for starting a separate commerce college. Thus Smt. Laxmibai Radhakisan Toshniwal College of Commerce came into being as a separate unit in the year 1964. Since then it has been working as a premier institution of commerce education in the western part of Vidarbha. The college initially imparted instructions up to undergraduate courses only. To cater to the needs of the student community, Post Graduate courses in commerce were added from the year 1972.

To encourage research in the field of commerce. M.Phil. course was introduced in the year 1983. In the same year, to train students in the field of business management, marketing and industrial relations, five more post graduate courses were added to the repertoire of the college viz. Diploma in Business Management, Diploma in Marketing Management, Diploma in Financial Management, Diploma in Taxation and Master of Industrial Relations & Personnel Management.

**The Department of Computer Management and Cyber Commerce started in the year 2000**, which conducts the Post Graduate course and Certificate Courses in Computer Management. With the opening of M.C.M. course, a big Lacuna in the field of Computer in the western part of the Vidarbha has been removed.

Prof. S. N. Agrawal was the first Coordinator of this course. After that Dr. T. G. Mirge was took the charge in 2007-08 and Dr. Nilesh N. Chotiya is the Coordinator since 2024 of this course.

The Department of Computer Management and Cyber Commerce is manned by qualified and experienced staff. Apart from teaching by regular staff, eminent guest lecturers are also invited from different fields to address the students. Field Visits are also arranged every year to give practical training and exposure to students. The college campus is buzzing with academic activities all-round the year.

## **About Master of Commerce (Computer Management) Course :**

This Course is conducted under the aegis of the Department of Computer Management & Cyber Commerce. This is a two-year, Semester Pattern Post Graduate Course leading to the degree of Master of Commerce (Computer Management) of S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati.

In the 21<sup>st</sup> Century, much emphasis is laid on Communication and Information Technology. The wonderful invention of computer and its growing popularity has revolutionized the communication world. ## **Project / Seminar:**

### **Project :**

Each candidate shall carry out a group project related to software /hardware development. The maximum size of the project batch shall be three candidates and minimum individual candidate.

The major objective of the project is to expose the student to teamwork, system analysis and design in practice. The project shall be based on current technological trend and it should not be a mere academic formality.

### **Each candidate shall prepare a project report containing the following details:**

- 1) Introduction
- 2) System Analysis
- 3) System Design
- 4) System Implementation and Testing
- 5) Conclusion

Evaluation of the project work is based on Internal and External examiners. The final marks will be allotted on the average of both the examiners that will be as follows Project evaluation 50 marks for each examiners and project viva 25 marks for each examiners. Minimum passing marks in project work will be 50% which will be average of part of project report.

### **Seminar :**

Topic of Seminar should be on current trend. A student will prepare a report and present it before the class, where there shall be two minimum teachers and this will be evaluated internally. The distribution of marks will be (30 marks for contents of seminar report & 20 marks for presentation).

## Common Rules for Students

- 1) Procedure of admission
  - a) Registration Form for admission can be obtained from the Department's office during 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on all working days.
  - b) Registration Form together with attested true copies of the following documents should be submitted to the Department within the prescribed time limit.
    - i) Attested true copy of College Leaving Certificate (T.C.)
    - ii) Attested true copy of mark list of the qualifying examination.
    - iii) Attested true copy of Migration Certificate (For candidates of university other than S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati.)
- Note:** Original Transfer or Leaving Certificate and Migration Certificate should be produced at the time of admission.
- c) The candidates provisionally selected for admission shall be required to pay the full fees as per fee schedule, failing which the provisional admission shall stand cancelled and no claim whatsoever in this respect shall be entertained. The student must submit the Bank Challan duly stamped by the bank immediately in the office in order to make his/her admission final.
- d) If for any reason a student leaves the Department after admission, he / she will not be entitled to any refund of fees.
- 2) The students admitted to Master of Commerce (Computer Management) course shall not take admission in any other university simultaneously.
- 3) Every student other than S. G. B. Amravati University, at the time of admission shall submit the Migration Certificate of the university from which he/she/is migrated and shall follow the procedure as per the norms of S.G.B.A.U.
- 4) Students shall attend the classes regularly and participate in field visits. Terminal examination, seminars, group discussions, assignments and other activities are organized by the Department. The admission is liable to be cancelled at any time for non-compliance.
- 5) Student should maintain discipline in the Computer Laboratory. They should handle the computers and other delicate equipment's with greatest care. If any damage or loss is caused to them due to negligence, the concerned student shall be responsible for such loss.
- 6) Students should not bring any outsider in the Computer Laboratory with them.
- 7) Every student shall keep in his/her possession an Identity Card in the premises and shall produce the same when demanded in the college.
- 8) Students shall park their vehicles at vehicles stand of the college.
- 9) Classes will be held from 8.30 a.m. to 01.30 p.m.
- 10) Ragging in any form/kind is strictly prohibited.
- 11) The decision of the Department in all matters shall be final and binding on all the students.

The Department extends the following facilities to the students:

- 1) Library : The Department maintains its own separate library.
- 2) Educational Aids : The Department possesses various educational aids such as Projector, Overhead Projector, etc.
- 3) Computer Laboratory : The Department houses a well-equipped air cooled Computer Laboratory for students.
- 4) Special Guidance : Special guidance is provided by the faculty to train the students as per need of an IT Industry.
- 5) Placement Cell : The placement facility is available for the students.
